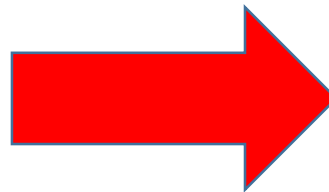

## School Voice

What we said ...

- A comprehensive transition plan for all children and year groups will take place throughout the summer term. Time will be spent in their new environments with their new teachers for 8 days before the summer break. A welcome meeting will also take place for you to meet staff and ask any questions about the next year group.
- Curriculum meetings will take place in the first half term of the new school year to support work at home. Glossaries of terms for specific areas will be shared in year groups and available on the newly organised website (Sept 2016)
- We continue to follow the government's guidelines on the new curriculum, assessment and testing. This includes year 2 and year 6 children taking examinations.
- Year group organisation varies, particularly in lower school. This depends on social interactions, academic needs and many other factors.
