

In a two parent household, both parents earn the equivalent of 16 hours a week (and less than £100 000). In a one parent household, parent must earn the equivalent of 16 hours a week (and less than £100 000).



If one parent is employed and the other is a carer or disabled or incapacitated. If one parent is on maternity or adoption leave or statutory sick pay.

We are working with DotsnSpots to look at how we can support this provision for you. We would like as many of our Children as possible to join our Nursery before they start full time school.
