**Are you struggling to make your money last? Have you experienced a sudden loss of income? Do you need some help?**

If so, Skelton Primary School is a provider of food bank vouchers for the Footprints in the Community food bank.

### **What does the foodbank do?**

Provision of emergency food parcels to local people in crisis. Three days food supply will be provided to clients referred via local agencies and frontline workers. Clients will receive a lunchtime snack and a listening ear and be signposted to other organisations that may be able to help with on-going support.

Foodbank clients are welcome at any of our Distribution Centres to collect their food parcels and receive a free lunch or snack. The nearest Distribution Centre is Loftus.
