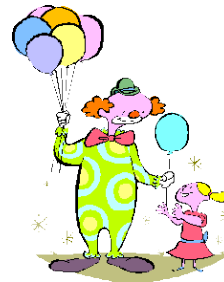


Mrs Chapman has 6 toys in a toy box to share between Sam and Maisie. How many different ways can Mrs Chapman share the toys between the 2 children?

Buying a Balloon



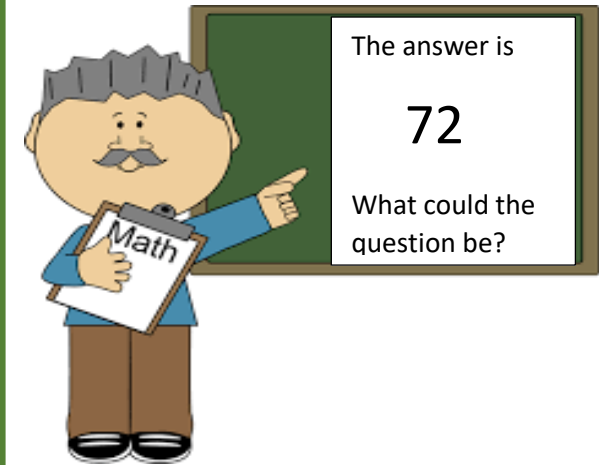
Lola bought a balloon that cost 12p at the circus. She had some 1p, 2p, 5p and 10p coins in her purse.
