SCHOOL COUNCIL

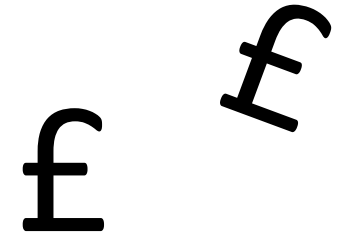
Thank you to all of the wonderful school council representatives from last year. You were an absolute delight to work with. Mr Campbell couldn't have done it without you.

If you managed to attend our recent Welcome Meetings, you will know that we are running a Loyalty Card scheme for this and next year. It is a way to collect discounts on trips and uniform by attending key events in the school year. We will be sending out cards to those families who did not collect theirs at the Welcome Meeting so don't worry if you do not have one yet. The good news is that you can continue to collect stamps next year as well so if you have missed an event, you could get it stamped during the following year.

Why are we running the scheme?

We enjoy a plethora of events, meetings, partnerships and social gatherings at school. However, we would like to encourage even more families to join us at these events.

Our Loyalty Card is one of our ways to say 'Thank You' for joining us. Not only will you enjoy the events planned and possibly learn some new skills, you will also be making savings against the costs of sending your children to school.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

1. You or a family member attend key pre-selected events throughout the year which are specific for your child.
2. Your card is stamped at each event.
3. You can redeem the value of your card against the activities/equipment listed on the reverse.

What do you need to do now?

Simply collect your card at your child's welcome meeting in September.

Bring your card to the events listed on the reverse of the card - the handy wallet sized card should make this easy.

A member of staff will stamp your card when you enter or exit.

Full terms and conditions and how to claim your discount will be attached to your letter and loyalty card when we send them to families next week.
