The school nurse will be in school to talk about healthy eating and to offer advice. All welcome.

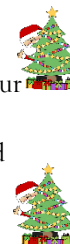

Operation Encompass is the reporting to us, by the police, prior to the start of the next school day, when a child has been exposed to, or involved in, any domestic incident.

Operation Encompass will ensure that a member of the school staff, (Mr Woolf), is trained to allow them to liaise with the police and to use the information that has been shared in confidence. This ensures that the school is able to make provision for possible difficulties experienced by children, or their families, who have been involved in a domestic abuse incident.
