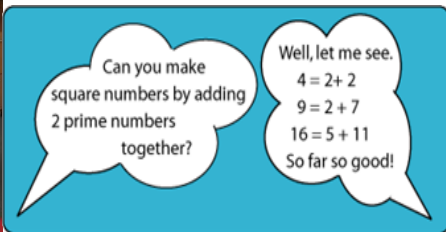
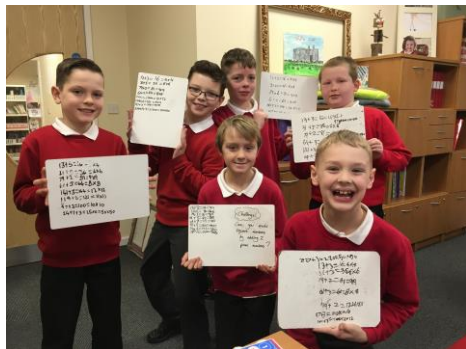

Ms Walker has met with our new School Parliament and shared a pupil version of the report & begun a pupil action plan. Children were most concerned about staff morale and have a plan! keep it high!

Mr Campbell will share the British values curriculum over the next 3 weeks on the Friday Flyer for you at home.

All staff are undergoing a review of the training they have had with an impact statement.

The Local Authority have undergone a thorough audit of everything to do with safeguarding at Skelton.

Our Foundation Stage outdoor area work is now complete. It looks great!

We have begun our governor review with the National Governor Association.
