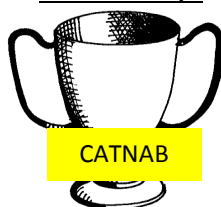
Dear Families,

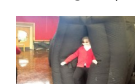

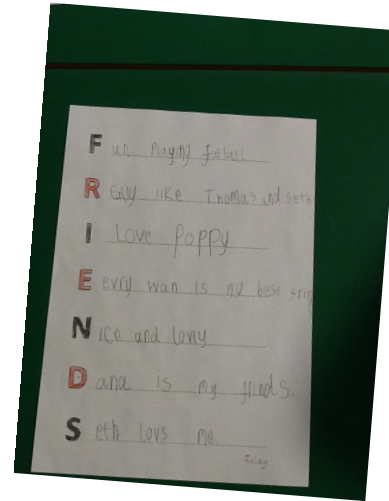

Each class has had a BLUE Anti-Bullying sheet for the children to sign to say they are against Bullying in any form. These will be put up on the classroom doors.

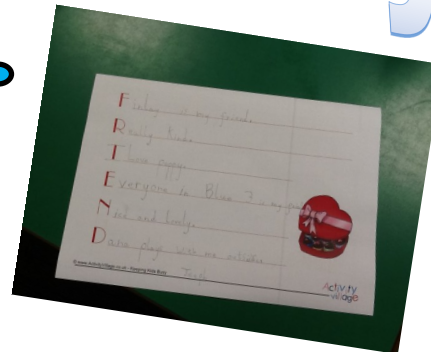
Each Y3, Y4, Y5 and Y6 has been answering an anti-bullying questionnaire. The results of which will appear on a future Friday Flyer.
