Y2

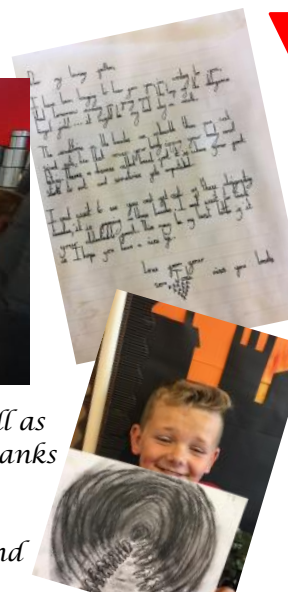


Y5
