
YOU DECIDE!

Last week we hosted a meeting of the You Decide! Steering committee. They have been tasked with ensuring that a pot of £3000 is made available by BID (up to £100 by an individual or up to £500 by a group) to the community of New Skelton.

The money could be used to enhance your street, by for example planting some flowers/plants or a group that you are part of for example buying coffee facilities for when you meet.

There is a very simple application form to complete and the bid process is open to anyone with a plan. The outcomes will be decided by community vote in early spring at an event hosted here in school. The only limitation is that the impact must be felt within the immediate community of New Skelton.
