Happy half term everyone. See you on Monday April 11th.

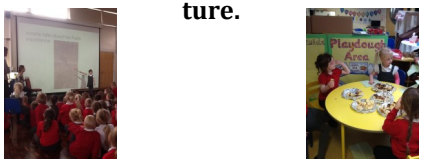
Y4

Our residential was a huge success We thoroughly enjoyed exploring York and its Viking history.

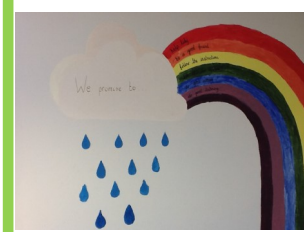


Y3
