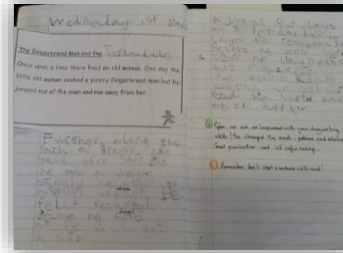
## What's new in Team Blue?



This half term Year 1 have been working their socks off!



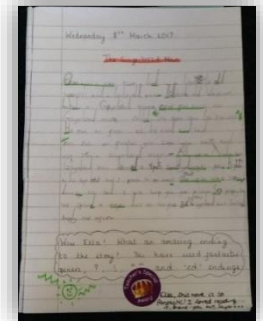

## *Hilaire Agnama*

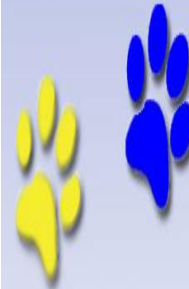
