



# Sector areas of focus

The current areas of focus for this sector are:

Antisocial Behaviour in Loftus

This remains an area of focus, particularly around the youth dub. We have been working with partner agencies to address the problems. We have increased patrols and have been working with young people in the youth club. A group of young people have been identified as causing anti-social behaviour and we are working with the Local Authority Anti-Social Behaviour Officer to tackle the behaviour of those responsible.

## News

- Earlier in the month, there was continued evidence of anti-social behaviour in Saltburn's Valley Gardens and the surrounding area. We have been patrolling the area at key times, faised with volunteers and viewed CCTV footage to identify those responsible. Enquiries are continuing.
- Our officers have carried out a number of engagement events across all areas. Please look at our Facebook page for further details.
- A number of allotments across the area have been targeted by thieves, so we have directed our patrols at key times
  and carried out a number of crime prevention and property marking events. Further events will be planned.
