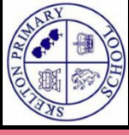
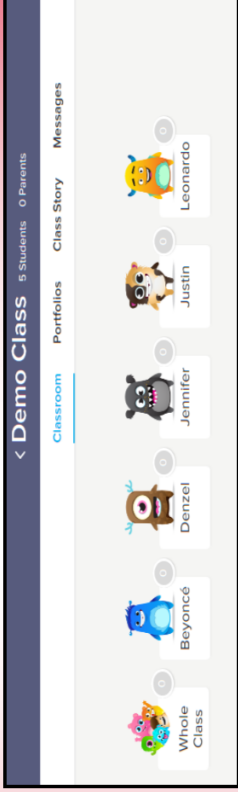
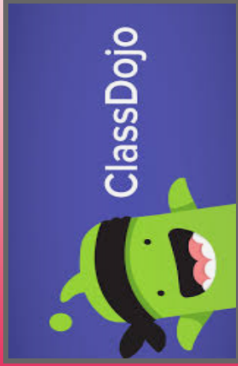

You may have heard your child talking about "Dojos".

At Skelton Primary School we use Class Dojo across our Key Stage Two classes to award children their behaviour points. Class Dojo is an online platform.

Children can be awarded behaviour points for positive behaviour that they show in and around school. Most behaviour points will be rewarded inline with our 5 Rs—for showing Resilience, for Reflecting on what they have learnt, for being Responsible, for being Ready or for showing Respect to those around the them. Class Dojo allows the teachers to give immediate feedback for what the children have done well, which is inline with our positive approach to behaviour at Skelton

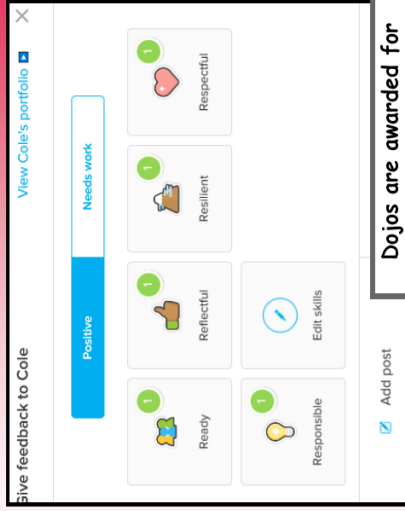
When children earn a point their teacher will award them the point on their class page and this will add to their total.

The children can see how many Behaviour Points they have earned on the Interactive Whiteboard in the classroom. The teacher will give the children targets to achieve in order to win small prizes e.g extra time on the castle or M.U.G.A.

It is worth stating that children will not lose a point for making a wrong choice once they have been rewarded.



Children are provided with an avatar on their class page which contains their cumulative behaviour points. Dojos are added when they are earned.
