## **FREE SCHOOL MEALS OVER CHRISTMAS**

Yesterday afternoon a meeting was held by the Council Executive Management Team. We can now confirm that the guidance sent last week has changed.

A decision was agreed to provide every Redcar and Cleveland Household where there is a Free School Meal interest some assistance during the Christmas Holidays.

A letter will be sent out to parents/carers by Friday of this week from the Local Taxation and Support Team informing them of the payment card, £15.00 per child per week.

There is a cut-off date for the payment card of Friday 11 December 2020, therefore, if you have not yet claimed Free School Meals and may be entitled please complete an application form, once processed Free School Meals will notify the Local Taxation and Support Team of eligibility.
