## PRIVATE FOSTERING

Please remember that any child not living with a parent, close relative or person with parental responsibility for more than 28 days is Privately Fostered and we are legally required to notify the Local Authority.

If you think that a child is being privately fostered, please contact school and speak to Mr Woolf or Ms Walker.



The symptoms of Covid are:

- A high temperature – this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature);
- A new, continuous cough – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or three or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual);
- A loss or change to your sense of smell or taste – this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal.

## WHAT IF A BUBBLE NEEDS TO CLOSE?

If we do have a positive case reported in school, we will carry out a risk assessment and may need to close a bubble.

If your child is in a bubble that needs to close

1. We will email you and ask you to collect your child. They will need to self-isolate at home for 14 days. If your child develops symptoms, they will need a test. If they receive a positive test, everyone in the household will need to isolate.
2. Home learning will begin with MICROSOFT TEAMS daily. Please download the app. More info will follow.

If your child is not in a bubble that needs to close, we will keep you informed.
