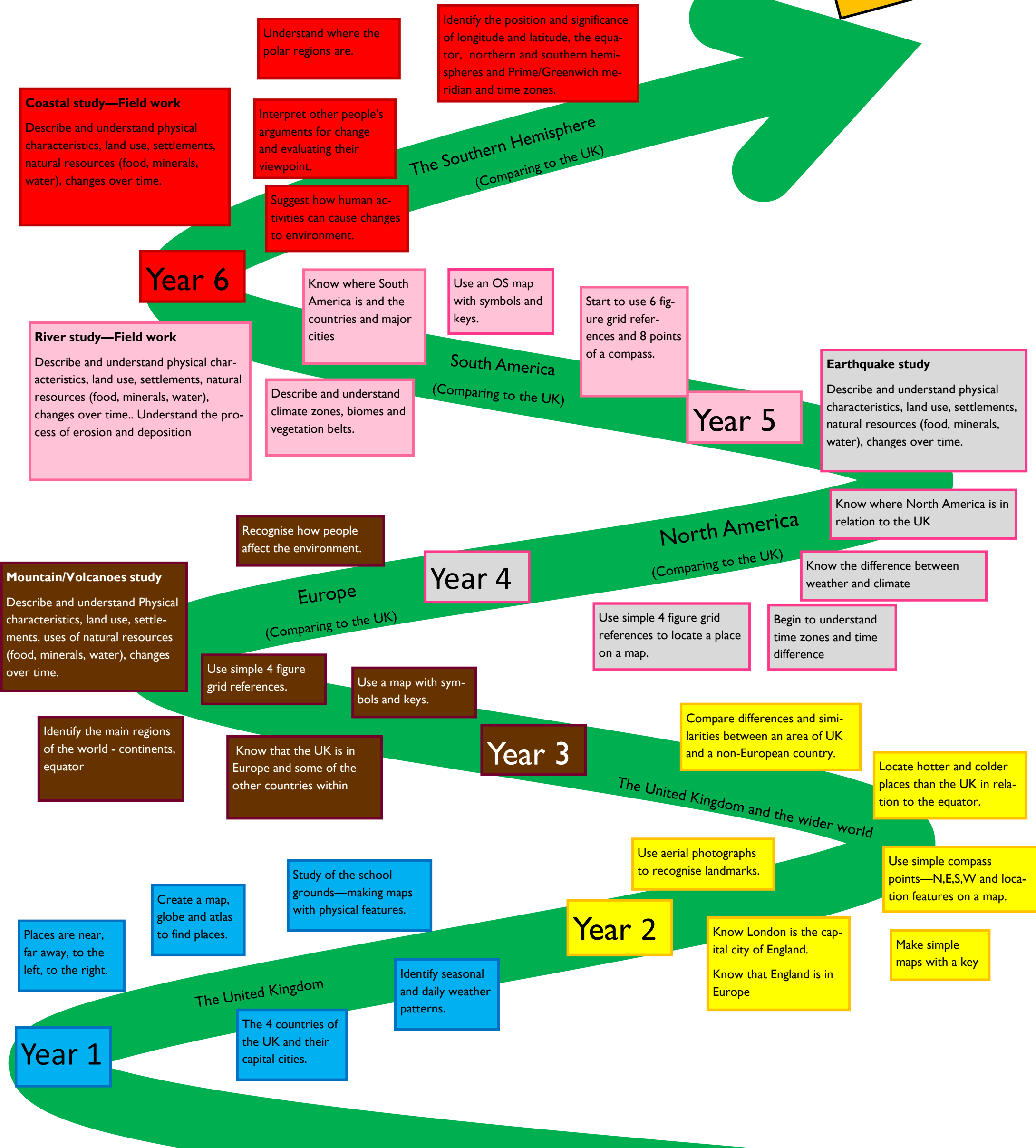

Children have first-hand experiences to explore, observe, problem solve, predict, think critically, make decisions and talk about the creatures, people, plants and objects in their natural environments.

Children will explore open-ended questions, for example, "What can you see here?" to help make connections between ideas.

Children also learn about seasons, the weather, features in the local area and the buildings that surround them. They will look at photographs of the local area to help them identify features, for example a library, railway, church or mosque. They will also be encouraged to record their findings, perhaps through drawing, writing, and modelling.
