Mr Woolf & I have attended some training this week and we were warned about some worrying statistics in the North East:

- The increase in knife crime
- The big increase in gangs, especially those recruiting 'teenies' (under 10s)
- The increase of County Lines: organised crime networks in larger towns and cities recruiting youngsters and vulnerable adults in villages and towns to deal drugs.
- Huge increase in online bullying, especially from under aged children using social media apps designed for over 13's. We have had a number of cases reported into school of parents asking for help.
