Yes, attendance is compulsory for all children from March 8^{th.}


Remote Learning Books Can stay at home if you would like to keep them. Those already returned will be available for you too.

LOCAL COVID TESTING FOR 18years +

The tests are available for anyone aged 18 years or over - inrespective of where they live - and who are not displaying Coronavirus symptoms. Anyone not displaying Coronavirus symptoms can book a test by visiting the Council's website at <u>www.reckrarchereland.gov.uk</u> or calling the contact centre on 016/2 714714. There are also a number of valki-in appointments available so the public can visit the safe for a test during opening hours. The testing will be supported by trained staff and the lateral flow tests will allow residents to test themselves before the results are analysed on-site. The results are usually available within 30 minutes.
