Loans can be used for any legal purpose and you can apply for up to £500 repayable over 26 weeks or 52 weeks.

Loan example: £300 loan, repayable at 52 weekly payments of £6.90. Total repayable: £357.24. Total cost of credit: £57.24. Fixed interest rate of 36%, APR 42.58%.

To be eligible for our Family loan you must:

- Be in receipt of Child Benefit and agree to have it paid into your South Tees Community Bank Account
- No credit check
- Be over 18 years old
- Have a high street bank account or a South Tees Community Bank ENGAGE account for disbursement of loan
